

## Manawatū Mountain Bike Club Terms and Conditions

Effective from 21 August 2025

As a member of Manawatū Mountain Bike Club Inc (MMBC), I:

- agree to participate in MMBC activities and events at my own risk.
- am aware of the risks inherent in mountain biking and I agree that I will not hold MMBC, the event organisers, landowners or sponsors responsible for any injury or loss I may suffer as a result of my decision to participate in MMBC activities and events.
- agree that MMBC may hold my personal information in the Club's records and share my details with Mountain Bike New Zealand (MTBNZ) and Cycling New Zealand (CNZ). I understand that the MMBC Privacy Policy can be found at [www.mmbc.co.nz/privacypolicy](http://www.mmbc.co.nz/privacypolicy)

I agree to the MMBC's event terms and conditions, as follows;

1. To wear a NZ Safety Standards-approved helmet while riding. (For downhill races a full-face helmet is mandatory. Please [read](#) Cycling New Zealand's DH protective equipment technical regulations - go to section 7.2 of the regulations).
2. That I am personally responsible for ensuring my bike is secured when on transport provided by MMBC and will not hold MMBC liable for any damage.
3. That if I need to stop on a trail, I will pull to the side and ensure that my bike and I are well off the trail.
4. At an MMBC event, if I injure myself or come across an injured rider, I must notify one of the event staff as soon as possible.
5. I understand that events will go on rain, hail or shine and if I choose not to participate because the conditions are not suitable to me, I will have no recourse against MMBC.
6. I understand that the organisers may alter the times, dates and conditions of an event by notice to me at any time.
7. I understand that if an event is postponed the organisers will advise me as soon as possible before the event and that I will have no recourse against MMBC if the change is not suitable to me.
8. That the decision of the Race Director is final, and in particular;
  - 8.1 In the event of any dispute, disagreement, or question arising in connection with an event, including matters relating to race results, participant conduct, or event rules, the decision of the Race Director is to be final, conclusive, and binding on all participants and parties involved.
  - 8.2 By participating in the event, I expressly agree to abide by and accept the Race Director's decision as final and waive any right to challenge or appeal such decisions in any forum, except as required by applicable law.
9. I agree to return any timing token assigned to me to the designated collection point at the conclusion of the race day in working order. If I fail to return my timing token by the end of the race day, or it is not in working order, I agree to pay a non-refundable fee of \$100.00 to cover the cost of replacement and administrative expenses. The fee will be payable immediately upon notification of the failure to return the timing token and the event organisers reserve the right to take necessary steps to recover the fee, including withholding race results or barring future participation until the fee is paid in full.

10. I agree that photos taken at MMBC events may be published on social media and used to publicise this and future events.
11. I agree to abide by any other subsequently advised event rules as set out by MMBC.

## **Manawatū Mountain Bike Club Refund and Cancellation Policy**

Effective from 21 August 2025

If you have registered for an MMBC Event and notify the Club 10 days in advance that you are unable to attend, or if the event is cancelled due to bad weather or unforeseen circumstances, MMBC will provide a full refund.

If you have registered for an MMBC shuttle session and notify the Club within six hours, the registration fee will be refunded minus the fee we are charged (roughly \$2-5) providing the shuttle is still viable to run. We will issue full refunds to all riders if the shuttle session is cancelled due to bad weather or unforeseen circumstances.

Most MMBC merch is produced after it has been ordered and paid for. Consequently, we are unable to offer returns or exchanges on MMBC merch. Please make sure you check the sizing before placing an order.

## **Manawatū Mountain Bike Club Shuttle Terms and Conditions**

Effective from 21 August 2025

1. Riders are personally responsible for ensuring their bikes are secured when on transport and will not hold MMBC liable for any damage to their property when using the shuttle service.
2. Prepaid shuttle sessions require at least 10 participants. An assessment will be made 12 hours before the shuttle session starts to determine whether or not it will run.
3. Shuttles may be postponed or cancelled at the last minute due to weather or unforeseen issues.
4. In the event of a change, the club will communicate to all registered riders by email. Please check the email associated with your Hello Club account.
